

COPPER CANYON GREAT TOUR

CHIHUAHUA – CREEL – COPPER CANYON – CEROCAHUI – EL FUERTE

ITINERARY 6 NIGHTS - 7 DAYS

DAY 1 (ORIGIN – CHIHUAHUA CITY)

- Arrival in Chihuahua City.
 - Airport transfer to the hotel.
- Guided City tour to the Metropolitan Cathedral, Government Palace murals, Quinta. Gameros, Historical Museum of the Mexican Revolution (Pancho Villa's house), Hidalgo's Dungeon and Colonial Aqueduct (3 hr. approx.).
- Museums closed on Mondays.
 - Hotel accommodation in Chihuahua City.



DAY 2 (CHIHUAHUA – MENNONITES - CREEL)

- Breakfast and check-out.
- 08:00 hr. Road transfer to the *Pueblo Mágico* of Creel.
- During the trip, there will be a visit to the Mennonite fields and to the Mennonite Museum of Cuauhtémoc City. Here, you'll learn about this cultural group originally from Canada and Europe, which established in the state of Chihuahua in 1920. The museum is closed on Sundays.
- Creel was founded at the beginning of the XX century as a logging town. It's considered to be the entrance to the Sierra Tarahumara. The main attractions it offers include the diverse Rarámuri communities that can be found surrounding the area and the beautiful landscapes such as waterfalls, lakes, religious missions, valleys with stunning ragged rock formations, among others.
- Hotel accommodation in Creel. Free afternoon. B.
- A walk through main street is recommended for Tarahumara art crafts. Also the Museum of Tarahumara Art is worth the visit.



DAY 3 (CREEL - COPPER CANYON)

- Transfer to the train station to board the *CHEPE EXPRESS* at 08:00 hr. (Economyclass). 1.5 hr. ride to Divisadero.
- The interesting part of the ride is to see “El Lazo,” which consists of the spot where the railway’s line loops around and goes under itself. It’s a loop of 360°.
- 09:55 hr. Arrival in Divisadero and check-in at Hotel Divisadero Barrancas.
- Divisadero is considered the most famous and important stop of the train’s journey. Thanks to its location as one of the highest points, it’s possible to appreciate up to 1,200 m deep. In addition to this, its magnificent views can be enjoyed in a more intense fashion through the attractions that the Copper Canyon Adventure Park offers.
- Lunch. During the afternoon, a 1.5 hr. walk to the Tarahumara cave lookout points where you’ll be able to appreciate the traditions of the indigenous people, the Rarámuri.
- Dinner. Accommodation at Hotel Divisadero Barrancas.

HOTEL DIVISADERO BARRANCAS is a lodge that’s been in business since 1973, built on the rim of the Copper Canyon. It’s well-known for its privileged location, being the only property with direct views to the Copper Canyon, Urique and Tararecua, and access on foot to the Copper Canyon Adventure Park.

DAY 4 (COPPER CANYON)

- Breakfast.
- 09:00 hr. Guided walk through the 1.5 km scenic path that includes extraordinary lookouts to take pictures, hanging bridges, and handmade craft stands, until you arrive at the famous lookout *Piedra Volada* (a steep, rock cliff with a pointy edge; above it, a “balancing rock”), and the entrance to the Copper Canyon Adventure Park. Undoubtedly, these are the best views of the Copper Canyon. The Park offers diverse extreme and adventurous tourist activities for visitors of all age ranges.
- Return to the hotel for lunch. It is suggested to take off an afternoon, in order to

- admire the spectacular views from the lobby bar.
- Dinner and accommodation at Hotel Divisadero Barrancas. B, L, D.

DAY 5 (COPPER CANYON - CEROCAHUI)



- Breakfast and check-out.
- 9:00 hr Road transfer divisadero – Cerocahui during the 1.5 hr. trip, there'll be beautiful landscapes to be appreciated such as vas rocky formations and mountain vegetation .
- Hotel Check In and Lunch
- During the afternoon, van tour to *Cerro del Gallego* lookout. Here, beautiful views of UriqueCanyon can be appreciated. Return to the hotel. Dinner.
- Hotel accommodation in Cerocahui. B, L, D.

It is Suggested a visit to the Tarahumara GirlsOrphanage and wine fields.

DAY 6 (CEROCAHUI – EL FUERTE)

- Breakfast and check-out.
- Transfer Cerocahui to Bahuichivo's train station.
- 11:25 hr. Board the *CHEPE EXPRESS* (Economy class) to El Fuerte. This is the most beautiful scenery of the train's ride. The train will pass through a series of tunnels and bridges that will allow you to appreciate the change in vegetation due to the descent from 1,625 m to 90 m above sea level.
- El Fuerte is a *Pueblo Mágico* from Sinaloa founded in 1564. It offers its visitors beautiful colonial architecture of the Mexican Pacific, as well as outstanding gastronomy. Guided walk through the town's square, a visit to the beautiful town hall and to the town's church. Time of arrival 15:35 hr.
- Transfer to the hotel. Accomodation. B.

It is suggested a visit to the indigenoucommunity of Capomos and El Fuerte Museum.

DAY 7 (EL FUERTE – LOS MOCHIS AIRPORT)

- Breakfast and check-out.
- Transfer: hotel – Los Mochis airport. D.
- End of services.
- Depending on the flight schedule, an early raft ride through El Fuerte river is recommended. The ride offers bird sanctuary and Sinaloa's native peoples' petroglyph sightings.
- On the way to the airport, we suggest a stop at Topolobampo bay and a boat ride to see the famous dolphin "Pechocho", and the chance to eat exquisite seafood at any of the restaurants lined up along *Playa El Maviri*.

- Road transfer Creel – Copper Canyon.

- 2 nights' accommodation. Three meals per person included.
- 2 guided walks.
- Road transportation Divisadero – Cerocahui.

▪ CEROCAHUI

- 1 night's accommodation at hotel in Cerocahui. Three meals per person included.
- Transfer hotel – train station in Bahuichivo.
- Tour to *Cerro del Gallego* lookout.
- Economy train ticket on the *CHEPE EXPRESS*. Route: Bahuichivo – El Fuerte.

▪ EL FUERTE

- Transfer train station – hotel.
- 1 night's accommodation; breakfast included.
- Guided walk through the *Pueblo Mágico* El Fuerte.
- Transfer hotel – airport in Los Mochis.



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
